
India's Success Roadmap 2020 – 2030










India's Nonwovens market grew steeply over the years with slight fluctuation in 2020 due to pandemic but bounced back with higher speed in 2021.

# Market Size by volume (tons/yr) for nonwoven technology in India, 2022




Overall, more than half of Indian market is dominated by spunbond, meltblown and spunmelt technology in 2022.




